REWARD ANNOUNCED IN FATAL HIT AND RUN OF 8-YEAR-OLD BOY

WHAT: On July 4, 2006, 8-year-old Felipe Ortiz Jr. was celebrating the 4th of July with his family by lighting fireworks on the street in front of his family's residence. A vehicle then struck Felipe and made no attempt to stop, leaving the area without rendering aid to Felipe. The child was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced dead.

The Carole Sund/Carrington Memorial Reward Foundation and the Santa Ana Police Department will announce a reward for information leading to the arrest(s) and conviction(s) of the person(s) responsible for Felipe's death. Anyone with information may remain anonymous and still be eligible to collect the reward.
